Corby AC made a great start to their McCain's UK Young Athletes League campaign when they hosted the opening match at the Rockingham Triangle. They easily won their Midland One North East from Daventry with Burton third.

Among the highlights was the treble from Rebecca Wymant in the Under-17 Ladies age group. She recorded victories in the 100m, 200m and the 300m before helping Corby to a win in the 4 x 300m relay.

Charlotte Cotter, who was also part of the relay squad, was successful when she landed a middle distance double while in the corresponding boys' age group Sam Foster added over a metre to his best when he took the hammer contest with an excellent Grade One performance of 52.92m.



Also achieving a Grade One mark was Under-13 Girl Sophia Martin, who clocked 10.3 in the 75m which was one of three races she won on a busy afternoon.

Jason Wong secured a fine sprint double in the Under-15s while also producing a new best was Jasper Larken who recorded a good winning mark of 2.11.2 in the 800m.

Emma MacFarlane was a triple winner in the Under-15 Girls section with her high jump of 1.53m being worthy of note. Courtney Bancroft-Morris (100m), Katie Fowler (200m), Helena Keenan (800m) and Abigail Morrow-Harris, who just held off club colleague Ellie Welch to take the 1500m, were other winners in this age group.
