Corby AC's first defeat in the McCain's National Young Athletes League this season saw the club receive a double blow when Sam Baker missed the landing bed in the under-17 pole vault and fell on to the concrete. He was rushed off to hospital but thankfully is now on the road to recovery. His best vault in the third round Midland One East match up to that point of 3.60m was good enough to win the event which contributed to the club finishing a distant second to Charnwood but more importantly narrowly ahead of host club Dudley.

Sam Foster (hammer) and Callum Logan (800m) were also winners in the age group while running well was Ross Davies who recorded a new 400m best of 52.4 for second place behind Charnwood's Aqeel Hassan (52.1).

Scott Kendall logged a throwing treble in the under-15 boys with his best performance coming with a new best of 35.08m in the discus while Jasper Larken was a double winner on the track – taking both the 200m and 400m. On the girls side Charlotte Bowling opened her day with a crushing win when clocking 45.5 over the 300m hurdles before just edging out Dudley's Kirstie Overfield to take the 300m flat by one tenth of a second in 42.8. Gaby Bangay with solid marks of 12.2 (80m hurdles) and 3.00m in the pole vault also excelled to record under-17 victories.

The under-15 girls proved their strength with five A string victories. Emma MacFarlane was responsible for two of them when she clocked 13.3 in the 75m hurdles and cleared 1.46m to take the high jump while Caitlin Davies won the B string with a fine 1.40m. Katie Fowler (long jump & javelin) and Beth Smyton, with a front running 800m victory in 2.25.4, were the other club winners in the age group.

Ellie Welch (2.34.5), who came out on top after a close confrontation with Charnwood's Hannah Cox (2.34.8) in the 800m, was the club's only under-13 girl winner.
