**Northamptonshire**

The hurdle events stole the show at Saturday's 75<sup>th</sup> Northamptonshire Schools Track & Field Championships which were held in brilliant sunshine at Corby's Rockingham Triangle.

The three new meeting records all came over the barriers with Lucy Hatton wiping out the oldest record in the book with a superb run in the Junior Girls 75m race. The Ise Community College pupil sliced a massive four tenths of a second from Diane Marson's 33-year-old record with a stunning effort which brought her home in a new lifetime best of 11.5.

The other two records came in the Inter age group courtesy of Themba Luhana and Charlotte Bowling. Luhana (Abbeyfield) equalled his best hand timed performance of 13.3 when he knocked two tenths of a second from Chris Hargrave's 1995 record with a slick run over the 100m hurdles and Bowling reduced her best hand timed clocking by one second when she shattered her year old record of 45.9 with her gutsy 300m hurdles solo run which saw the Prince William School pupil hit the finish line in 44.5.

All three marks were beyond the National Standard (set by the English Schools Association for outstanding performances) as was that of Rachel Tyler (Bishop Stopford) who retained her Inter Girls discus title with her third round throw of 36.10m.
