Sam Foster came within 20cm of his best when he won the Under-15 hammer at the Peterborough City Games. The Corby AC National champion disposed of the stiff opposition provided by the Norwich pair of Michael Painter (51.19m) and Callum Brown (51.06m) to win with 55.18m.

Also winning for Corby in the same age group was Garnett Walters who cleared 1.75m to take the high jump while Emma MacFarlane, with a clearance of 1.39m, was another high jump winner when she took the Under-13 Girls' event.

Gabby Bangay just edged out Thurrock's Hayley McLean to win the Under-15 Girls' 75m hurdles after both runners were credited with the same time of 11.7 and she also cleared 2.60m for victory in the pole vault.

Beth Smyton was another winner in this age group for Corby when she defied the windy conditions to take the 800m in 2.24.7.

Other winners for Corby were veteran Tony Wells, 400m in 62.9, Seb Gough, Under-20 long jump with 6.16m, Under-17 Harry Hollis with 50.17m in the javelin, Fraser Dalby, who clocked 1.59.3 in the Under-11 600m and Rachel Backhouse, who threw 40.92m in the Senior Women's discus.
