

Peterborough Open Meeting



Erik Aselius made a fine start to this track season when he was among a number of local athletes competing in the Peterborough Open Graded meeting. The Corby AC sprinter finished runner up in the Under-20 100m in 11.3 behind the impressive Chris Craig of Peterborough, who posted a useful early season mark of 11.0.

Other good sprinting from the Corby camp came from Beth Garvie who registered an excellent time of 13.2 (100m) and 27.6 (200m) for wins in the Under-15 age group.

Seb Goodall with 2.08.7 in the Under-17 800m also won for Corby as did Emma MacFarlane who clocked 14.7 in the Under-13 Girls' 70m hurdles. She was also victorious in the field when she cleared 1.40m to take the high jump while Lauren Boyd also triumphed for Corby when putting 9.53m in the Under-20 shot contest.

Grace O'Carroll with 20.47m in the Under-20 javelin and Scott Kendall, whose reward for a good winter's training was a splendid throw of 33.78m in the Under-15 javelin, were also winners for Corby.
