

Thorney 10km

Chris Curtis gave a good indication that he is over the illness that hampered the tail end of his cross country season when he convincingly won the Thorney 10km road race.

The Corby AC man was never troubled as he raced home in 34.48 to finish ahead of the Peterborough duo of Matthew Axton (35.37) and Oliver Mason, who just pipped former Kettering Town Harrier Ian Aunger (Nene Valley Harriers) by one second to take third in 35.43. Barry Wake (KTH) and Ian White (Corby AC) were also in action with the former running 41.03 for 34th and White's time of 41.18 slotting him into 38th.

Corby's final runner competing was John Thomas who ran 42.29 for 54th which easily gave him top spot in the veteran-65 age group.
