

Thorney 5

Two days after finishing a fine fifth in the Blisworth 5 Corby AC's Chris Curtis was again in action on the roads when he competed in the Thorney 5.

On this occasion the 29-year-old produced another excellent run to finish third in 27.25 as Notts AC's Ashley Sabin convincingly won in 26.01 from Peterborough's Ashley Allen (27.08). Harborough AC's William Clapp ran well to clinch the runner-up spot in the veteran-40 section behind former Kettering Town

Harrier Ian Aunger (Nene Valley Harriers) who won in 28.30, with his time of 29.24 giving him 17th position overall.

Brigstock's Kate Armstrong returned from injury to finish a fine second in the ladies race. She clocked 32.34 behind Nene Valley Harrier Tanya Taylor who was only seven seconds ahead at the finish.

Also performing well to take third place in 32.52 was Loddington's Yvonne Scarrott whose run secured her top spot in the veteran-40 section.
