

**European Veteran Track & Field Championships**  
**July 23<sup>rd</sup> – August 3<sup>rd</sup> 2008**

Tony Wells bowed out of the Veteran-55 age group in fine style with a relay gold and two individual silver medals at the European Veteran Track & Field Championships in Ljubljana, Slovenia.

The Corby AC headmaster got his campaign underway when he qualified for the final of the 400m hurdles with a heat winning time of 67.91. He then returned the following day for the final and clocked a season's best of 66.28 to take the runner-up spot just ahead of Ludvik Toman of Czechoslovakia (67.35) as fellow Briton Robert Stevenson lifted the title in 61.34.

After a four day break Tony then lined up in the 100m hurdles, which was a straight final, and narrowly lost out to Finland's Arto Miikkulainen (15.67) with his time of 15.83 (another season's best) with Italian Tullio Hrovatin taking the bronze in 16.78.

Wells ended his final race in this age group at these championships with his contribution to Great Britain's sprint relay victory when they took the title in a time of 48.96 ahead of Italy (49.61) and Germany (51.59).
