

Moulton 10km 27th August 2007



The second running of the Moulton 10km saw both the male and female winners set new course records.

A convincing victor in the men's race was Salford Harrier South African Pumiami Bangani (left) who cruised around the tough one lap course in 32.17. His time was nearly a minute and a half faster than Matt Almond's (spectating on this occasion) record of last year. Behind the winner Corby AC's Chris Curtis (left) continued his fine form on the roads when he beat the two runners who finished ahead of him at the recent Wellingborough 5. He clocked a pleasing 34.17 to come home ahead of Kettering Town Harrier Nigel Marley (34.48) and Rugby & Northampton AC's Stuart Nelson (35.04). The race, which is part of the Northants Road Running League, saw several county runners

secure useful points. R&N's Vince Carroll held off Wootton Road Runner Chris Gallagher by four seconds to take fifth in 36.21 while Corby's Troy Garrity ran well to clock 36.52 for eighth. Mick Wilcox (R&N) was next and his run of 37.02 took the top veteran-50 prize ahead of Corby's Pete Gray (38.11).

Brian Summers (R&N) just held off Fleckney & Kibworth's Ian Gladwell by one second to win the veteran-40 age group in 37.32 with David Rayfield of Northants Police taking third in 38.17 while Wellingborough & District AC's Tony Hale (45.07) was runner-up in the veteran-55 section behind Midland Master Alan Webb (40.40).

Veteran-40 Sally Cartwright (Bedford Harriers) knocked a similar amount of time as the men's from the course record when she came home in 42.09 while Mareee Jesson (43.02) of the host club Northampton Road Runners ran well to clinch the runner-up spot ahead of St Albans Strider Gillian Jubb (43.19) and in the process finish top veteran-35.

Kelly Leonard turned in a fine run to take fourth in 43.45 while her R&N club colleague Angela Copson produced an excellent effort to finish sixth in 44.17 and easily win the veteran-60 top prize with the host club's Lita Hickey clocking 48.45 to clinch first place in the veteran-50 section.
